

Valentine Party Coordinators

You are responsible for planning and executing the annual Valentine Party.

The Valentine Party will immediately follow the annual Talent Show (which is being coordinated by another person.)

We want to keep our parties very SIMPLE this year.

There is a \$50 budget. Use this budget to purchase a very simple snack for the kids. (Valentine cookies and juice?)

Steps for planning....

- 1.) Begin announcing the party via the website email and during class announcement time in early January.
- 2.) Encourage families/kids to make and bring a decorated box/bag for collecting Valentines in.
- 3.) Encourage families to bring Valentine's for their kids classes ONLY. (For instance, preschoolers will only give Valentines to other preschoolers.)
- 4.) We will then open up the gym for playtime and you can also coordinate families to bring board games as well.

KEEP IT SIMPLE! Valentine distribution, cookies and juice, playtime/board games.

(Please remember that the 7th-12th graders will NOT be a party of the parties this year. They will still have classes the day of the party. However, we can still bless them with cookies/juice. =)
