

Sensory Room Set-up / Clean-Up

The Sensory Room Set-up and Clean-up families are responsible for the set-up and clean-up of the nursery/preschool sensory room.

The sensory room consists of bean boxes, rice boxes, water boxes, puzzles, play dough and other simple sensory items.

The sensory room items are all kept in the Anchor storage area at First Baptist Church. They can be found there for set-up and should be returned there for clean-up.

For Set-Up:

The sensory boxes simply need to be brought out of the storage area and set up in the sensory room. (Last room down the long hallway, past the preschool room, across from the science room.)

- Set the sensory boxes out on the tables and remove the lids.
- Fill the water box up with 2 inches of water. You can get water from the bathroom or the kitchens.
- Set out the puzzles and play dough.
- Have the room set-up and ready for the nursery/preschool kids to walk into and begin sensory play.

For Clean-Up:

- Empty the water out of the water box. Dry with paper towels.
- Replace the lids back on all the sensory boxes.
- Pack up Puzzles and Play Dough.
- Wipe down tables with a wet rag/disinfecting spray.
- Return sensory boxes to the storage area.
